Here's a couple of pix of the cabinet I made for my daughter and some spoons & a fork I made as gifts for Christmas. The finish on the cabinet is not what I would have chosen. But my daughter is very happy with it. It took some fiddlin' around to get it to the point she was happy!! The spoons and fork were made from scrap oak and poplar, with pieces glued together where needed. Hence the visible changes in wood grain. I plan to make more spoon/forks using some good wood. I just wanted to practice the carving/sanding techniques. The finish is Odie's Oil from Rockler. You rub it on, wait a few hours and then buff it off. Food safe so the label says. The finish is satiny smooth.
